## **Engineers Australia 2016 SH-SSP Scholarship**

### **The scholarship benefits**

Payment in full of the Program Fee of A\$12,900 for attendance at the Southern Hemisphere Space Studies Program from 11 January to 12 February 2016 which includes all tuition, accommodation and meals.  
*(The scholarship does not include the cost of travel to Adelaide and is not transferable to a later program).*

### **Who is eligible to apply?**

Engineering graduates and engineering undergraduates in the final two years of their engineering studies:

- resident in Australia
- who have applied for enrolment in the Southern Hemisphere Space Studies Program and
- who do not have financial support to attend the program from their employer or other sponsor

**Selection criteria**

The Engineers Australia Selection Committee will select the scholarship winner taking into account:

- the applicant's motivation to forge a career in space engineering in Australia
- the applicant's academic performance and/or qualifications; and
- the applicant's financial circumstances

**Documentation required**

All applications will be judged on the basis of the information and supporting documents lodged as part of the on-line enrolment process at <http://www.isunet.edu/apply-online-shssp>

**Conditions of award of scholarship**

The scholarship winner may be requested by Engineers Australia to carry out the following actions following the program:

1. Submit a written report at the conclusion of the SH-SSP describing the program and how they believe the SH-SSP will help them to further advance space engineering within Australia.
2. Prepare and deliver presentations to national conferences and/or public presentations, describing their experiences from the program, and their future prospects as a result of their attendance.
3. Assist Engineers Australia in the promotion of the scholarship to the wider engineering and public communities.

**Notification**

The winner of the scholarship will be notified no later than 31 October 2015.
